Gala Grazing Brome is densely tillered and endophyte free. In dry regions with sandy soil, Gala continues to perform better than traditional ryegrass pastures despite heavy grazing or poor management. When allowed to fully establish Gala will provide years of grazing. Strong autumn through winter growth makes this brome an ideal constant grazing pasture year round. Gala provides rapid regrowth and excellent animal performance, as well as a permanent cover crop in vineyards and orchards.

Seeding Rate: 25 lb/ac, mix 10 lb/ac Planting Time: Spring-Fall Regions: West, South First Grazing: 100 days
