Graza is a hearty forage radish that produces remarkable digestible dry matter even in drought conditions and has survived down to 15° Fahrenheit. Bred for soft leaves to enhanced palatability, this brassica is an excellent addition a summer grazing crop in a mix with warm season grasses and herbs. Graza possesses the compounds necessary for an effective biofumigant cover crop. It's high biomass production complements any green manure cover crop program.

**Seeding Rate:** 5lb/ac; Mix 1-2 lb/ac

**Planting Time:** Apr-Sept

**Regions:** All

**First Grazing:** 40 days

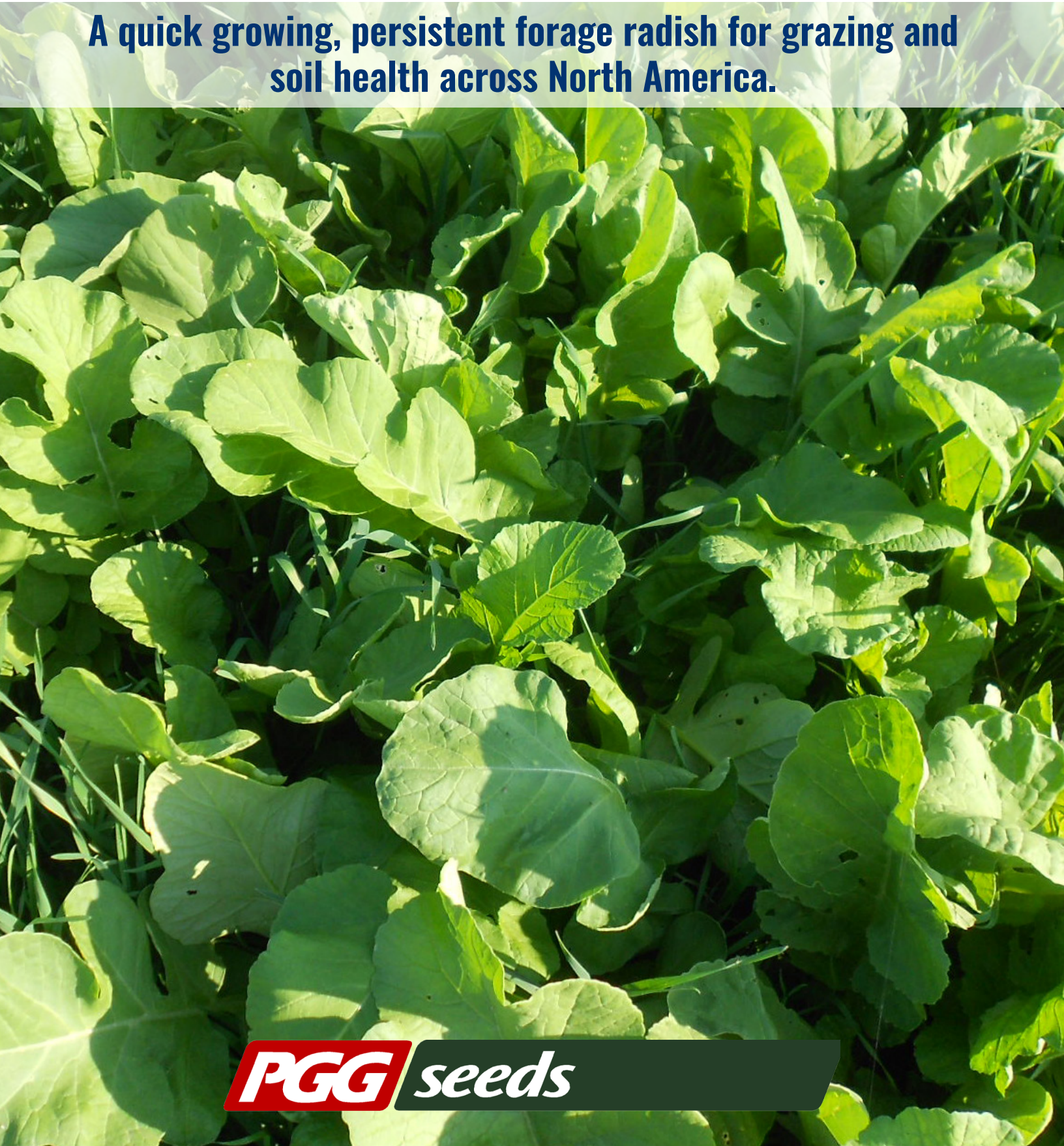
