




A high energy, cool season forage leaf turnip with superb regrowth.

Hunter Leaf Turnip can be spring sown after March for early, cool season forage; planted in summer before September this turnip rape provides high energy, cool season quality. Hunter will regrow and flourish under multiple grazings through summer and into fall with irrigation, as early as 40 days from seeding. With it's minimal bulb development, Hunter is a excellent companion to both cool season relays and warm season mixes.

Seeding Rate: 3-4 lb/ac; Mix 1-2 lb/ac Planting Time: Apr-Sept Regions: All First Grazing: 40-60 days
